

## HOW TO LOG AT YOUR ACCOUNT IN NOTOS?

### 1. ON YOUR PERSONAL COMPUTER

Create the directory 'MYWORKS':

```
makedir MYWORKS <ENTER>
```

```
cd MYWORKS <ENTER>
```

TO this end, you may also use the 'MIDNIGHT COMMENDER':

```
mc <ENTER>
```

```
F7 MYWORKS ..... and quit immediately the 'mc'.
```

### 2. NOW FROM THE DIRECTORY 'MYWORKS' ON YOUR PERSONAL COMPUTER:

- LOG ON DELTA:

```
ssh (-Y) atol.icm.edu.pl <ENTER>
```

```
password:.....<ENTER>
```

- LOG FROM DELTA ON NOTOS

```
ssh (-Y) notos <ENTER>
```

```
password:.....<ENTER> (Password the same as for DELTA)
```

### 3. CREATE THE DIRECTORY 'MYPROGRAMS' on NOTOS

```
makedir MYPROGRAMS <ENTER> (or using mc)
```

```
cd MYPROGRAMS <ENTER>
```

### 4. CREATE THE FILE, say PROGRAM1.f (for program written in FORTRAN), IN WHICH YOU WILL WRITE YOUR PROGRAM: To this end you may call editor vim:

```
vim PROGRAM1.f <ENTER>
```

```
<INSERT>
```

Then begin to write in the column Nr 7:

```
.....PROGRAM PROGRAM1
```

You can continue in vim editor, but perhaps it is more convenient to quit the editor vim and then continue to write using the editor incorporated in the **Midnight Commender**, which we call using key F4.

In order to save the text written and to quit the editor vim: use

**<ESC> <SCHIFT> ZZ**
