Dear Mr. Marciniak,

I hope all is well. I am forwarding some reports about the education system in Bulgaria. I think they would give you all the context you'd need.

I spoke with the World Bank team here. They will help us set up three meetings on Thursday before the conference: one with the minister of education and the ministry's general secretary (the highest civil service / expert position); one with MPs and members of the parliamentary committee on education; one with World Bank staff. They want to focus all conversations on school system reform so no need to prepare anything on the topic of higher education in Poland.

Unfortunately it's too early to set up the meetings. We currently have a caretaker government. The parliamentary snap-elections will take place on October 5th. Hopefully we will have a new government by mid-October, then we'll proceed to invite the key people.

One request - the report on PISA 2012 results by the World Bank is a working draft. The WB team asked that we don't distribute it to third-parties yet. Please keep it confidential until they release the final version as they might do last-minute edits, etc. Still, it's a very good document, when you read it you will see why Poland's experience is so relevant and important for Bulgaria to study carefully.
