**Full time job,** period of employment: **4 years** with the possibility of extending for an indefinite period of time after a positive result of employee evaluation.

The successful candidate will conduct research and teaching in some of the following areas: programming, operating systems, computer networks, web applications, security of computer systems and cryptography

Requirements: a candidate for the adjunct position should have:

- 1. a PhD degree in computer science or related fields achieved during the last 10 years
- 2. strong publication record in international computer science journals or conferences
- 3. teaching experience in some of the areas listed above
- 4. international experience (projects, conferences, internships)

**Applications**: in order to apply for the position a candidate should submit to the Dean's office (room 2260, Banacha 2) or send as attached pdf files the following documents:

- 1) a cover letter addressed to the Dean of the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Mechanics, (with the consent to the processing of personal data for the purpose of recruitment in accordance with the Act of the Protection of personal data.);
- 2) a copy of PhD diploma;
- 3) a scientific CV with a list of publications;
- 4) copies of selected publications (no more than 3);
- 5) research statement regarding future plans related to specialization (no more than 2 pages);
- 6) names and contact details of 3 possible referees;

The applications will be evaluated by a selection committee appointed by the Dean of the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Mechanics, University of Warsaw. The committee may invite a candidate to the meeting.

The conclusion at the latest – June 30 th, 2019 (e-mail notification). The competition is the first stage of the recruitment process as described in the Statutes of the University of Warsaw, the recommendation by the selection committee being a basis for subsequent stages.
