HOW TO LOG AT YOUR ACCOUNT IN NOTOS?

1. ON YOUR PERSONAL COMPUTER

Create the directory 'MYWORKS':

makedir MYWORKS <ENTER>

cd MYWORKS <ENTER>

TO this end, you may also use the 'MIDNIGHT COMMENDER':

mc <ENTER>

F7 MYWORKS and quit immediately the 'mc'.

- 2. NOW FROM THE DIRECTORY 'MYWORKS' ON YOUR PERSONAL COMPUTER:
 - LOG ON DELTA:

ssh (-Y) atol.icm.edu.pl <ENTER> password:.....<ENTER>

• LOG FROM DELTA ON NOTOS

ssh (-Y) notos <ENTER>

password:.....<ENTER> (Password the same as for DELTA)

- 3. CREATE THE DIRECTORY 'MYPROGRAMS' on NOTOS makedir MYPROGRAMS <ENTER> (or using mc) cd MYPROGRAMS <ENTER>
- 4. CREATE THE FILE, say PROGRAM1.f (for program writen in FORTRAN), IN WCHICH YOU WILL WRITE YOUR PROGRAM: To this end you may call editor vim:

vim PROGRAM1.f <ENTER>

<INSERT>

Then begin to write in the column Nr 7:

.....PROGRAM PROGRAM1

You can continue in vim editor, but perhaps it is more convenient to quit the editor vim and then continue to write using the editor incorporated in the **Midnight Commender**, which we call using key F4.

In order to save the text writen and to quit the editor vim: use

$$\langle ESC \rangle \langle SCHIFT \rangle ZZ$$
