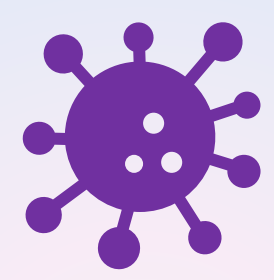


COVID-19 in New Zealand

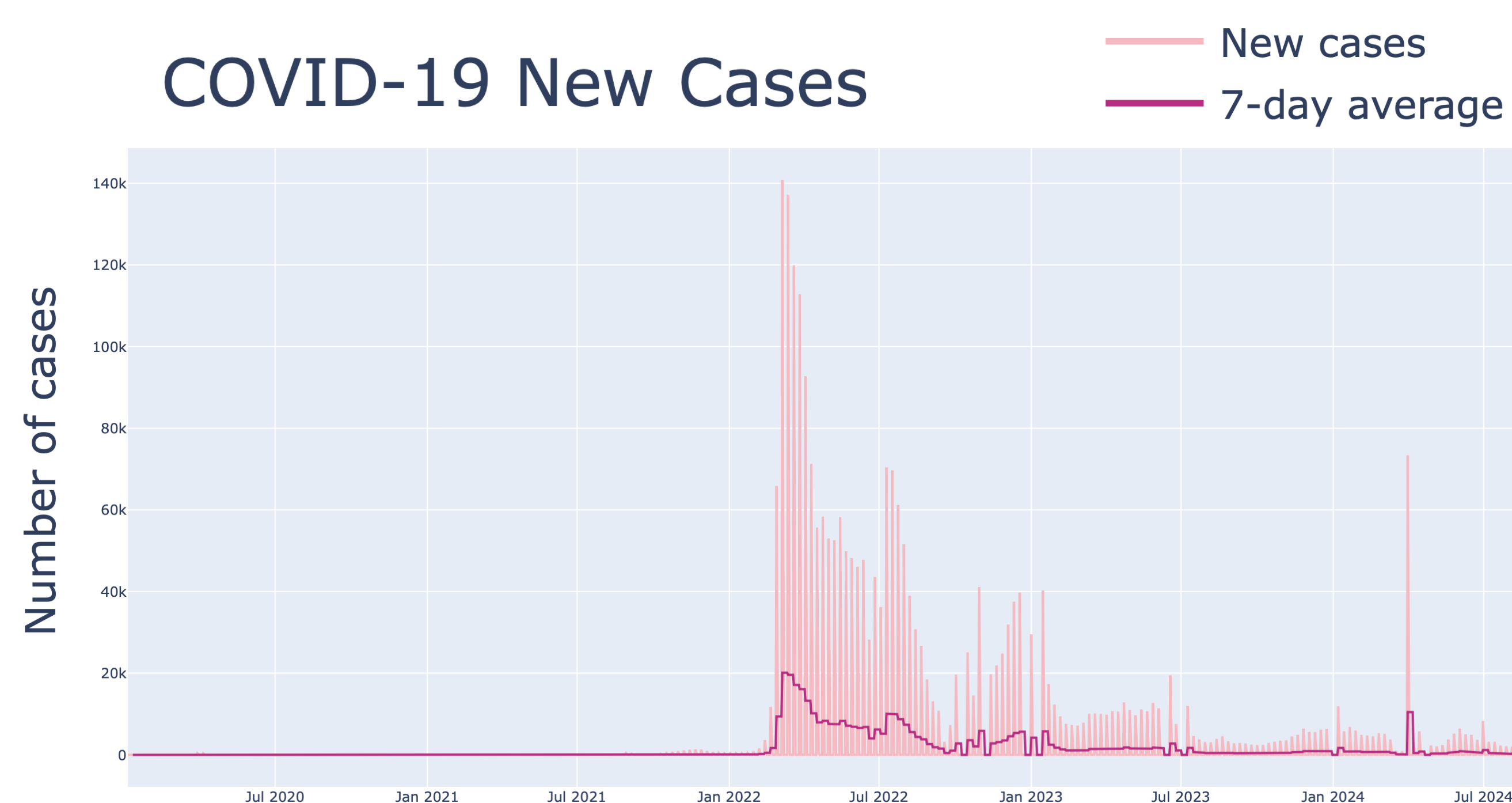

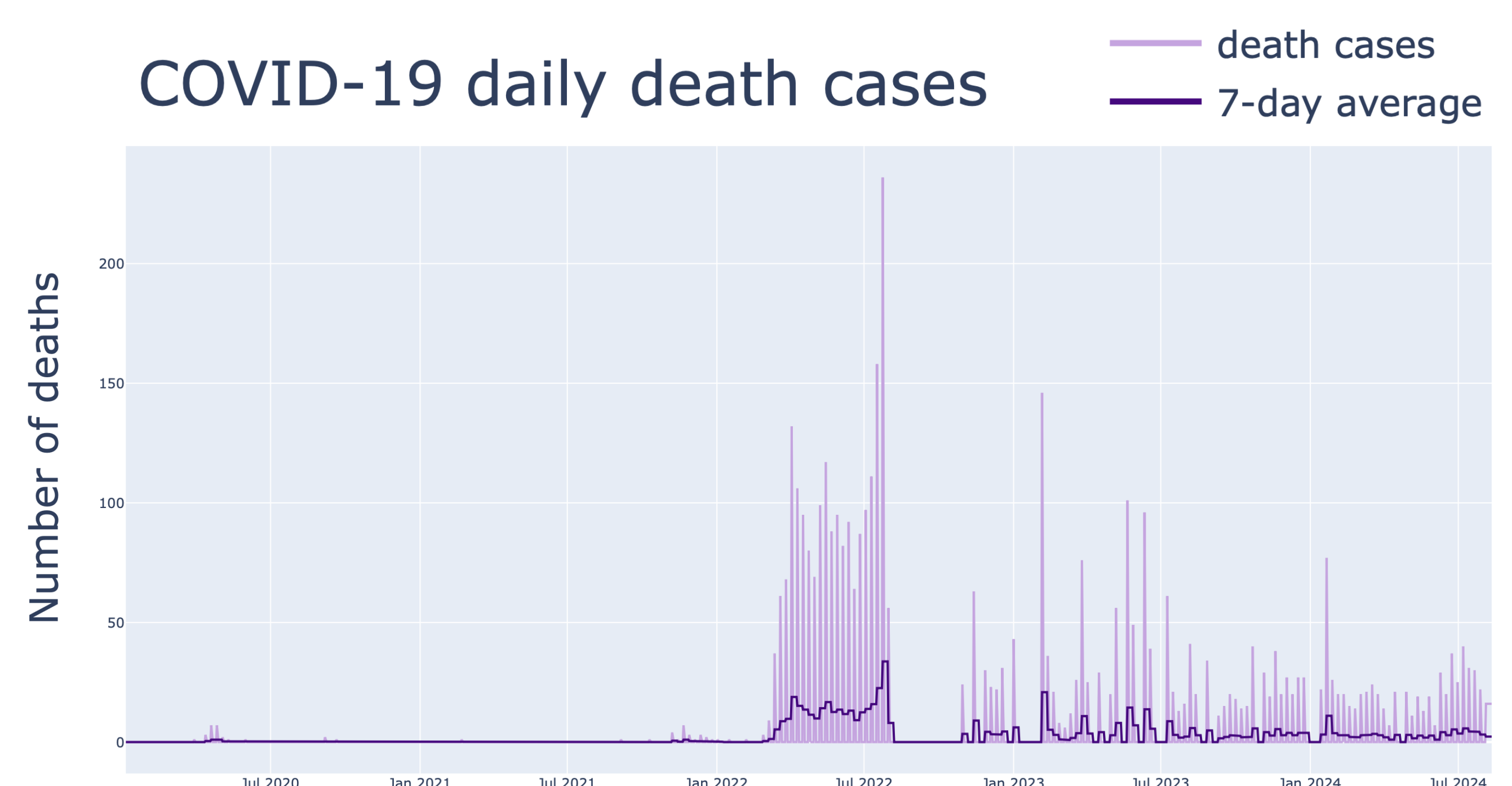

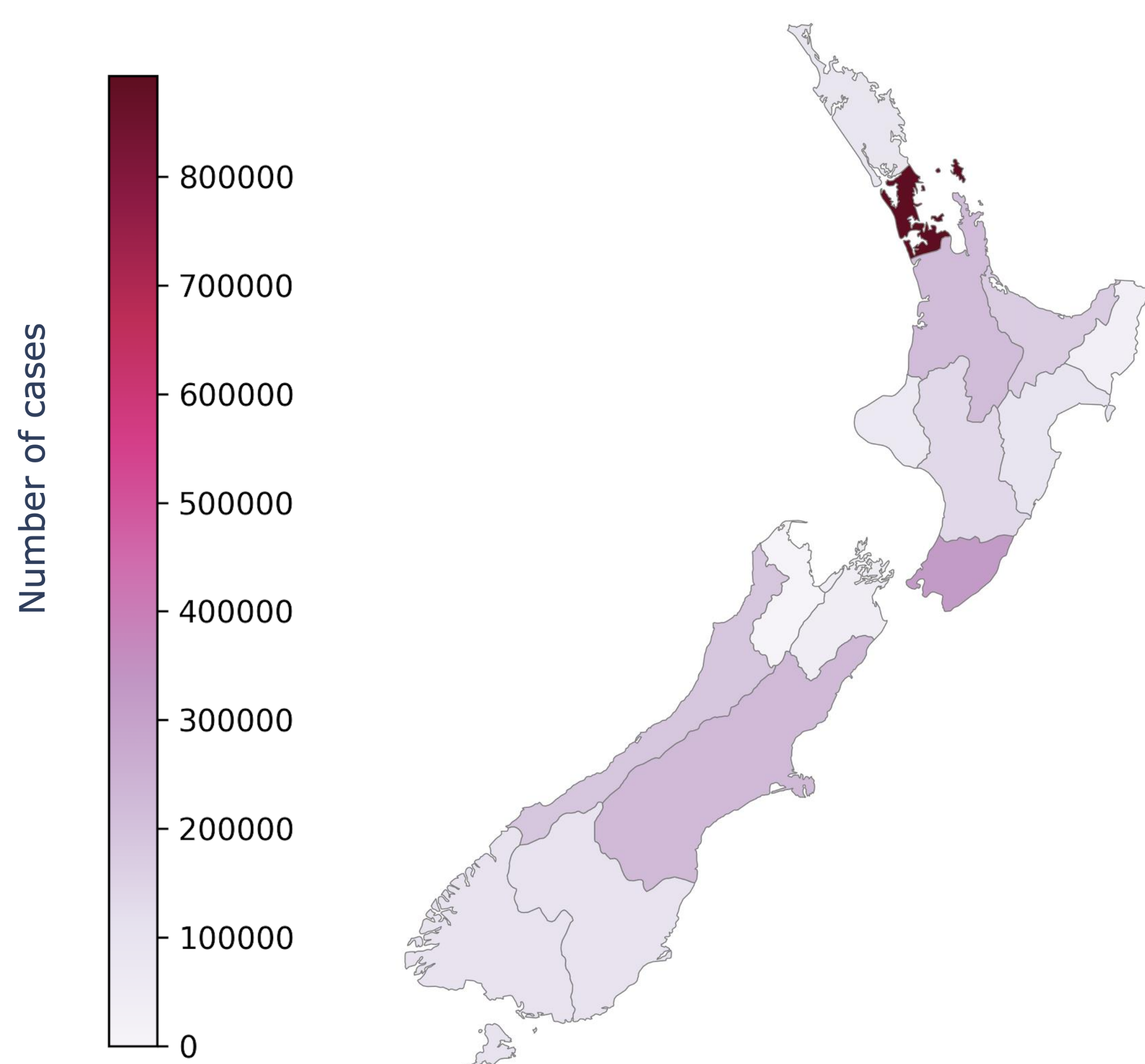
