

## Algorithms seminar 2021/22, rules for PhD students

1. The seminar takes place every second week, on Thursdays at 12:15.
2. PhD students can obtain credit for participating in the seminar. This counts as *research seminar* in their PhD programme.
3. The will to formally enroll in the seminar should be indicated at the beginning of the winter semester.
4. Credit for participation in the seminar is provided based on two premises: *attendance* and *presentation*.
5. *Attendance*: The student should regularly frequent the seminar throughout the whole year. Since the seminar takes places only once in two weeks, it is required that the student frequents also some other seminar(s) of their selection, with at least similar frequency. 6. *Presentation*: Since the seminar has a research character and takes places every two weeks, we will not make an attempt of accommodating talks from all PhD students enrolled in the seminar. Instead, in order to pass the seminar, it is required that throughout the year the student gives at least one talk at any place. This could be our seminar, some other seminar, a guest talk at some other institution, a talk at a conference or a workshop, or even a talk at a semi-formal reading group. The talk should be in English.
